

# **INTRODUCTION**



#### **PROFILE**

SAFEnet is a regional digital rights organisation based in Denpasar, Bali, Indonesia.

SAFEnet was founded in 2013 with a vision of realisation of a digital space that upholds human rights values for all people.

Its mission is to defend digital rights in the Southeast Asia region, including the right to access the internet, the right to express freely and the right to be safe in digital spaces.

# **CHALLENGES & IMPACTS**



## Key Issues on UPR 3<sup>rd</sup> Cycle

- 1) Providing protection the Human Rights Defenders,
- Repealing blasphemy law,
- 3) Ending discrimination and violence against women and minority groups such as LGBTIQ,
- 4) Ensuring human rights obligations in Papua
- 5) Protecting human rights in particular freedom of expression, association and assembly

Indonesia is partially implementing the recommendations or even not complying with previous recommendations.

#### **Current Situation**

- 1) In 2020, 67 cases of blasphemy occurred, 43 of these cases occurred online.
- 2) From 2018 through 2021, 56 cases targeted toward Human Rights Defenders. 147 digital attacks in 2020 and 193 attacks in 2021. Almost 60% targeted to Human Rights Defenders.
- 3) 510 OGBV cases in 2021, which many cases targeted toward WHRDs.
- 4) In 2021, 476 accounts have received a warning from Virtual Police for allegedly containing hate speech content.
- 5) The Indonesian government has shut down the internet in Papua and West Papua in 2019. In 2020, 4 reports of partial shutdowns. And in 2021, 12 reports of internet outages.

## RECOMMENDATION



- i. Repeal blasphemy laws that contravene the right to profess and manifest religion or belief online.
- ii. Provide comprehensive holistic protection to Human Rights Defenders, from judicial harrashment and offline and online attacks.
- iii. Comply with all of its obligations under CEDAW to eliminate all forms of discrimination against women and gender minorities and protect their sexual and gender expression on the internet.
- iv. Lift all forms of unlawful surveillance, censorship, Internet shutdowns, and suppression of information on the internet.
