## **ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO PORTUGAL – ADD.1**

## LIECHTENSTEIN

- Liechtenstein recognizes Portugal's commitment to international criminal justice, as evidenced by its continued support for the International Criminal Court and its implementation of the Rome Statute crimes into domestic law.
- What steps has Portugal taken toward completing its process of fully aligning its national legislation with the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court, in particular by incorporating provisions to cooperate promptly and fully with the Court?
- What steps has Portugal taken to ratify the Kampala amendments to the Rome Statute?
- What steps has Portugal taken to prevent excessive use of force and ill-treatment by law enforcement officials and members of the security forces?
- What steps has Portugal taken to bring the conditions of detention in places of deprivation of liberty into line with the Standard Minimum Rules for the Treatment of Prisoners?

## **SPAIN**

- How does Portugal value the work carried out by the National Human Rights Commission since its creation in April 2010 as an organism in charge of the supervision and completion of international obligations on the matter?
- How does Portugal value the functioning of the NIAVE Project (*Núcleo de Investigación* y *Apoyo a Víctimas Especiales*), particularly regarding the way it affects the rights of women and children?
- What steps has Portugal taken in the implementation of the United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights?
