UPR: Cyprus

The life of those in hunger strike is in danger although they begun to drink fluid due to the promise of Minister of Interior, Mr Hasicos.

To prevent harsh attacks to asylum seekers, such as what happened at 12th July 2011 at the detention center in Larnaca we recommend more human rights trainings for police forces as well as detention center personnel and all those who are somehow in connection with asylum seekers due to their job. We also recommend ratification of of ICRMW.
