ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO THE CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

(SECOND BATCH)

GERMANY

- The Central African Republic is still a country of origin and transit for trafficking in human beings. Acts of trafficking in human beings, linked with sexual or economic exploitation, are sentenced with up to ten years prison according to art. 151 of the Penal Code. However, no systematic prosecution of acts of trafficking in human beings takes place. What kind of steps is the government taking to improve the prosecution of trafficking in human beings?
- The rights of the child are still very restricted in the Central African Republic. Child labor is still a common phenomenon and recruitment of child soldiers has been practiced by several armed militias in past years. What measures does the government take to improve rights of children?
- When will the independent "Commission Nationale des Droits de l'Homme", created in October 2017, take up its work?
